

WERA OUTSTANDING DISSERTATION AWARD

Purpose: To recognize exemplary dissertation research by doctoral students related to improving K-12 or higher education.

Awards

- One-year complimentary membership in WERA.
- Presentation of a plaque at the WERA/OSPI Annual Conference.
- Complimentary WERA/OSPI Annual Conference registration.

The committee may recommend more than one award each year. An award will be granted only if the Committee deems that a dissertation is exemplary.

Eligibility: Candidates must have successfully defended their dissertation and been awarded a doctorate degree by an accredited Washington state institution in the calendar year in which the application is due.

Application Procedure

- 1. Submit one electronic copy of the complete dissertation.
- Submit an electronic overview of the dissertation. This "overview" will be the primary source of
 information for identifying Dissertation Award winners. The overview must be fewer than 5 pages
 (including graphics and appendices) and must include the following elements: (See the rubric on the
 following page.)
 - A problem statement detailing the question investigated in the dissertation
 - A description of the data and methodology used
 - The contribution of the analysis to the understanding of the broader question being investigated
 - A discussion of the applications and limitations of the analysis
 - The recommendations from the research
 - The applicability of the findings to school districts, state departments, universities, or research organizations
- 3. The chair or member of the dissertation committee must submit a letter of endorsement that does the following:
 - Attests to the nominee's eligibility,
 - Specifies the meritorious nature of the dissertation as it relates to the evaluation criteria, and
 - Indicates the nominee's current position, address, and telephone number.
- 4. The dissertation, overview, and letter of endorsement must be sent to the WERA Awards Committee at weraoffice@gmail.com by December 31 of the year in which the dissertation was defended or the doctorate degree was awarded.
